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WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 21st day of February, 1939, considered the report filed with said Board in accordance with the provisions of the District Investigation Act of 1933 upon the proposed Yolo County Fire Protection District in Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors by resolution duly passed and adopted by said Board, at said meeting, found and determined that there were no legal objections to the formation of said proposed fire protection district and decided to establish a county fire protection district in Yolo County to be known as "Yolo County Fire Protection District in Yolo County" to consist of the following unincorporated territory within the County of Yolo embraced within the boundaries described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, T. 10 N. R. 2 E., M. D. B. & M; thence Northerly along the Section line between Sections 16 & 17 to the center line of Cache Creek; thence Easterly and Northeasterly down and along the center line of Cache Creek to its intersection with the center line of the Southern Pacific Railroad; thence Northeasterly up and along the center line of the Southern Pacific Railroad Property to its intersection with the Section line between Sections 3 & 4 of above mentioned Township and Range; thence Northerly 2 miles, more or less, along the last mentioned Section line and along the Section line between Sections 33 & 34, and 27 & 28, T. 11 N.R. 2 E. to the corner common to Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28, T. 11 N.R. 2 E; thence Westerly 12 miles to the quarter-corner common to Sections 20 and 29, T. 11 N.R. 2 E; thence Northerly one mile to the quarter-corner common to Sections 17 and 20, T. 11 N.R. 2 E; thence Westerly  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles to the Northeast corner of Section 24, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Southerly one-half mile to the quarter-corner common to Section 19, T. 11 N.R. 2 E. and Section 24, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Westerly one mile to the quarter-corner common to Sections 23 and 24, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Southerly one—half mile to the Southeast corner of Section 23, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Westerly one mile to the Southeast corner of Section 22, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Southerly one-half mile to the quarter-corner common to Sections 26 and 27, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Westerly one mile to the quarter-corner common to Sections 27 and 28, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Southerly one-half mile to the Southeast corner of Section 28, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Westerly one and one-half (12) miles to the quarter-corner common to Sections 29 and 32, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Southerly one-half mile to the center of Section 32, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Westerly

one-half mile to the quarter-corner common to Sections 31 and 32, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Southerly one-half mile to the Southeast corner of Section 31, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Westerly one mile to the Southwest corner of Section 31, T. 11 N.R. 1 E; thence Southerly about 2½ miles to the point of intersection of the Section line between Section 13, T. 10 N.R. 1 W. and Section 18, T. 10 N.R. 1 E. with the Grant line along the Northerly side of Rancho Guesisosi; thence Southeasterly about 3 miles along said Grant line to the Northeasterly corner thereof; thence Southerly along the Easterly line of said Grant to the center line of Cache Creek; thence Northeasterly down and along the Southerly center line of Cache Creek to its point of intersection with the Section line between Sections 12 and 13, T. 10 N.R. 1 E; thence Easterly about one-half mile to the corner common to said Sections 12 and 13 and Sections 7 and 18, T. 10 N.R. 2 E; thence Southerly one mile, more or less, to the Southwest corner of Section 18; thence Easterly 2 miles to the point of beginning; and

WHEREAS, the said Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo sitting in regular meeting on said 21st day of February, 1939, passed and adopted a resolution calling a special election to be held in said county fire protection district on the 28th day of March, 1939, for the purpose of determining by the vote of the qualified electors of said district the question as to whether said Yolo County Fire Protection District shall be established and for the purpose of submitting to the electors at said election the proposition of electing E. L. Baird, Albert W. Schneegas and George B. Weiss as directors of such county fire protection district; and

whereas, said resolution calling said election contained and provided for all of the things required by law concerning the holding of said election; and

WHEREAS, the notice of said election prescribed in said resolution was duly published and posted in the manner and for the length of time required by law and as directed by said Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and regularly held in said proposed Yolo County Fire Protection District, as directed by said Board of Supervisors, on the 28th day of March, 1939; and

WHEREAS, the returns of said election have been filed with said Board of Supervisors in the manner and form required by law; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo has duly canvassed the said election returns of said election;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California:

- l. That at the special election held in the hereinabove described Yolo County Fire Protection District in the County of Yolo there was submitted to the duly qualified electors of said district the propositions: "Shall the Yolo County Fire Protection District be established", and "Directors Vote for three E. L. Baird, Albert W. Schneegas and George B. Weiss", and opposite and to the right of said proposals on the ballots voted at said election were printed the words "Yes" and "No" together with voting squares;
- 2. That there were forty-nine (49) votes cast at said election; that forty-six (46) votes were cast in favor of the proposal to form said Yolo County Fire Protection District and three (3) votes were cast against the said proposal; that each of said proposed directors received the following votes: E. L. Baird thirty-two (32) votes; Albert W. Schneegas thirty-two (32) votes and George B. Weiss thirty-two (32) votes;
- 3. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo find and determine, and it does hereby find and determine, that at such election, that is to say, the election held in the herein-above described Yolo County Fire Protection District on the 28th day of March, 1939, a majority of the votes cast ratify the declaration of said Board of Supervisors made on the 21st day of February, 1939, deciding to establish a county fire protection district within the unincorporated territory in the County of Yolo, State of California, hereinabove described, to be known as

Yolo County Fire Protection District in Yolo County; said Board of Supervisors further hereby finds and determines that at said election said E. L. Baird, Albert W. Schneegas and George B. Weiss received the highest number of votes for directors of said district;

- 4. That this resolution making the aforesaid findings be entered upon the minutes of said Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo forthwith and that thereafter said Yolo County Fire Protection District in Yolo County embracing the unincorporated territory in the County of Yolo within the boundaries hereinabove described shall be deemed to be established and organized, and shall in fact be established and organized, as a county fire protection district;
- 5. That said E. L. Baird, Albert W. Schneegas and George B. Weiss be, and they are hereby, declared to be duly elected to the offices of director of said Yolo County Fire Protection District.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED and the Clerk of this Board is hereby authorized and directed to cause a certified copy of this resolution to be immediately filed for record in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Yolo, the County within which the land situated in said Yolo County Fire Protection District is wholly situated.
